Later in the day, I observed the man attending one of our Bible studies. He stayed until the very end and I noticed that there were tears streaming down his face.

Kevon's Story-7 Miles in My Shoes

On Labor Day of 2018, I was released from prison after serving a 6-year sentence. I walked out with nowhere to go and no prospects. My adulthood had been overladen with heavy drinking and prodigal living, which understandably did not leave welcoming doorsteps from my family. An uncle took pity on me and allowed me to live in a tent on his vacant land. However, this put me far out in the Adna area.

In order to look for something to eat, or for work prospects, I had to walk daily into downtown Chehalis. It was a grueling 7-mile journey. One day, I walked past a little red mission that was open for hot meals to anyone hungry. This quickly became my new regular hangout.

I was able to find odd jobs and was working hard to get my life back on track. Two of the Mission's volunteers, Tad and Paul, became my friends and mentors. They encouraged me to also become a volunteer at LCGM, which I still am to this day.

I now have my own place in Centralia and work steadily. I still find myself walking the distance between downtown Centralia and the Lewis County Gospel Mission from time to time, but now it's for a different reason. Instead of journeying for myself, I make these steps for others. I want other men facing my similar circumstances to know that there's hope for their future.
