US SUPREME COURT DECISSION REGARDING PUBLIC CAMPIING

On June 28, 2024, the US Supreme court released a ruling that allows Cities (and other public property owners) to ban camping in public places. This ruling will empower many communities to shift their public camping policies to more strongly discourage those who find them selves homeless from "camping" in public places. This is a very complex issue and it most likely will not be the final word on this issue. Mean while, here is a suggested stance from the CITYGATE network which the Lewis County Gospel Mission is a member of:

- <u>BE OPEN:</u> May the doors of your mission swing wide for the increaser influx of those seeking hope from you.
- <u>BE WILLING</u>: May your hearts extend the love of Christ with an orientation that desires to be a central part of the solution within your city or community.
- ♦ BE READY: Make sure you are prepared and receptive to offer a well-run, welcoming, and safe place.

SMALL-SIZED COMMUNITY BASED REENTRY PROGRAM SUPPORT



The Lewis County Gospel Mission is one of sixteen nonprofits around the state of Washington that are apparent successful contractor. This program will bring additional resources to those recently released from incarceration to Chehalis and the surrounding Lewis County. The Lewis County Gospel Mission has been actively involved with this portion of our community since it was founded in 1996. The state funding available through the Washington Department of Commerce will allow us to extend our hour of operation for ALL of our guests. In addition, there will be a more formal relationship with partner service providers and greater networking for improved reentry success.

There is an ever increasing demand for statistical information when applying for grants and donor accountability. The Lewis County Gospel Mission is working with a local developer to digitally record information on our guests and the services that they receive. We will also be tracking referrals to partner service providers and the progress being made.
